### Criteria for Acceptance into the Early College Program

- Grades:
  - Students must have earned a C or higher in their Mathematics and English courses in 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Students must be reading at grade level or be no lower than two grade levels behind per Reading Inventory (RI) assessments taken in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Consideration of attendance history
  - Attendance will be reviewed to ensure there is no pattern of absences (not including legitimate reasons for absences) that could adversely impact success in the program.
  - Students must have zero truancies (unexcused absences).
- Review of discipline history
- Parents must agree to attend six parent meeting nights throughout the school year.

## Student and Parent Expectations

### Student Expectations

- I will maintain good ATTENDANCE in all college courses AND Orange High School courses.
- I will make education a priority and understand that taking college classes while in high school is challenging and will require extra study time at home.
- I will show respect to all members of the school community including the SCC instructors teaching the concurrent enrollment courses. I will behave in a manner that is appropriate to a college setting including having all materials read and assignments completed per the syllabus before each class session.
- I will seek help if I am struggling **EARLY** so interventions and support can be provided to me before it is too late. If tutoring is recommended, I agree to attend tutoring until I am able to demonstrate that I no longer need the additional support per my grade improvement or my Early College Support teacher deems it no longer needed.
- I understand that participating in this program may limit my ability to participate in other programs such as AVID, athletics, band, choir or ASB.

- I will attend the six parent meeting nights throughout the school year.
- I will ensure my child maintains good ATTENDANCE in all college courses AND Orange High School courses.
- I will regularly check in with my child to ensure all homework and assignments for college courses and Orange High School courses are complete.
- I will utilize Aeries gradebook to monitor my child's grades.
- I will communicate with the Early College Support teacher if I have any questions or concerns about my child's progress in their college classes.
- I understand that participating in this program may limit my child's ability to participate in other programs such as AVID, athletics, band, choir or ASB.
