3. Budget Update/Spend Down – Tran

 - LCFF – about \$10,000 – about \$5000 moved for Leadership Academy/remainder for Large Display (Say), Drone (Meza), and purchase of 5 Voice Amplification systems focused on Languages Dept.
 - Additional Comment – Cafeteria now has provisions for parents and school events; also simplified presentation electronics (McCuistion)
4. Students' Reports – Diego Paz
 - All is well/Cross Country has wrapped/Schedule is strange knowing some classes are done for year
 - Question regarding student sentiment about hybrid (Meza) – Sports offers incentive to coming back in person
5. Principal's Report – Dennis McCuistion
 - Acknowledgement of Meza, et al, for video productions showcasing the school and other activities (Bowman)/Offers good real-world life skills building for a digital age
 - Athletics – Starting to get back to normal/Indoor sports beginning Wednesday (no spectators)/Some restrictions still apply/away games based on varied policies of home districts – patience encouraged
 - Graduation – Current status - In-person with 2 spectators per graduate/Possibly graduate Wednesday night
 - District implemented Self-Study (equity) – More information to come
 - SBAC/AP/ELPAC – Most students choosing to do tests online
