 - Goal 1

 - 2.4 – Library is now complete

4. Students’ Report – Theresa Perez, Samuel Mendoza Rodriguez, Emelynh Tran
 - “There is a need for more water bottles; or at least some vending machines with water.” Perez
 - R: “Since, COVID funds have stopped, the district has stopped sending water bottles as they had done last year. But we are looking for water vending machines.” Anderson-Glass
 - “Lunch lines are difficult to get through. There’s a lot of pushing and shoving.” Mendoza Rodriguez
 - R: “Some kids are leaving classes early and get to the lines before adults. We used to have a gate that we would put out to direct traffic. The hope is to have more security that will monitor the area ahead of time.” Visconti
 - R: “This will be looked at further.” Anderson-Glass

-Football – “Noticing how small the student support is for the games. Would like to see more students engaged.” Perez

Comment: “The recent game was also during the holiday break, which is tough for students to come out.”

-900 Building Doors – “They took out the doors with all glass and put in doors with windows. Odd.” Tran

R: “By law the doors have to have a window in them.” Anderson-Glass

-CIF Runners-Up in Football

-Clubs on campus are very active

-Added 4 portables to the basketball courts to house remaining teachers in the 100s/200s/ teachers must be moved out by 12/2 in preparation for Phase 2 construction

-New portables will eventually replace older ones and likely to add more newer ones eventually

R: “The evacuation sites will be adjusted to outdoor theatre and other areas.” Anderson-Glass

-100s Bathrooms going away/Bathrooms available in 500s, 900s lower and upper floors

R: “ELA Department had this pushed out to students already but will send a reminder in December News You Can Use.” Visconti

-Compliments to the seniors who work with the Special Education population on our campus. “They are not just engaging with the students during the school day, but they go out of their way to invite them to events outside of the school day on their own personal time.” Bustrum

-Umbrellas needed for tables – “There’s not enough shading, especially near Mr. Paez’s room. It gets very warm sitting at the tables.” Bustrum

R: “Shade structures are being worked on. We have some umbrellas that could possibly be put at some of the tables, but not all.” Anderson-Glass

-Buttrey’s class has worked with Mr. Lentz’s mod/severe students for the past several years, giving students an opportunity to work with his class and create more experiences for the both sets of students. Buttrey
